

Wearing of Face Masks

You must wear masks on entry to the school Reception/Office area and the school building.

We strongly recommend you wear masks at drop off and pick ups.

As part of our risk assessment to reduce the transmission of Covid amongst the school community we ask all adults in school to wear masks in corridors and public spaces. We have several cases of Covid already in school and we ask parents/carers and families to continue to take sensible precautions to keep themselves and their families safe. Please inform us immediately if you or your family test positive for covid. Thresholds in school of 5 cases or 10% of those who have been in close contact ie a class, will still require reporting to NYCC for public health advice.

Thank you to parents/carers for waiting in a distanced line for drop off and pick ups. As it can be a bit congested with people coming in and out of the one gate, we are strongly recommending parents/carers wear masks at pick up and drop offs and are insisting masks are worn on entry to the school office area into the school building.

Car Parking

To keep our children safe, please do not park in the staff car park or on the turning circle. Please park considerately on surrounding streets or use the car park just inside Harrogate High School gates, on the right.

Bring Coats to School

Please ensure that the children come to school with a coat as they will be going outside fresh air at playtimes and lunchtimes even when the weather is changeable. Uniform Requirements
