New Term Normal Start and End of Day

At present we are going to start the new term by returning to normal start and finish times for the school day. 9 o'clock start and 3.20 finish.

All children will come into school via the big grey gate at the far end of the school building. The door from the playground to the school will be open from 8.50. On the first morning the teachers will be out to welcome the children and ask them to line up in their new classes, so they can get ready to go into class together. At the end of the day parents can wait in the playground behind the lines of planters/seats and teachers will bring classes out and ensure parents are there to hand the children over.

New Reception 2021 children will wait outside the EYFS classes within the red fenced area to be welcomed by their class teachers and teaching assistants 8.50 -9.00 and wait here to pick up at the end of the day at 3.15-3.20.

If there are any other updates and changes to the covid-19 restrictions, we will let you know through Claslist announcements before the start of term.
